Rabbi Nathan Alfred is the new spiritual leader of the Free Synagogue of Flushing. British-born, he has served Jewish communities in Europe and Asia, including in Belgium, Luxembourg and Singapore.

Rabbi Alfred read Classics at King's College,

Cambridge, where he excelled in Latin verse composition and student politics. After finishing university he moved to Budapest to play chess, and whilst in Hungary achieved the title of Fide Master. He studied for the rabbinate in London and in Jerusalem, gaining semicha in 2008.

Renowned for his entrepreneurial approach and innovative programming, Rabbi Alfred has built communities in far-flung parts of the globe, including in Vilnius (Lithuania) and Bali (Indonesia). He created the virtual community "EuroJews", a dynamic and successful young professional group in Europe. He envisioned and taught the Baalei Tefillah Europe program, training lay leaders to lead prayers in 14 European countries. A former member of the Executive Board of the World Union for Progressive Judaism (WUPJ), Rabbi Alfred speaks English, French and Hebrew, and now lives with his family in Jerusalem, Israel. He is excited to meet FSF members and all who are interested to work together to build up this historic community.

The Free Synagogue of Flushing is honoured and delighted to welcome Rabbi Alfred, who will officiate over the High Holydays alongside Cantor Alan J Brava.
